

Below is some information about the main ethnic groups in Bulgaria (based on the last census from 2011):

Individuals with Bulgarian origin	84.8% of the population
Individuals with Turkish origin	8.8% of the population
Individuals with Gipsy origin	4.9% of the population (for at least 25-30% of them Turkish is mother tongue)

The rest (1.5%) of the population belongs to different small ethnic groups

There is no information about individuals with English or Italian background.

There is a trend of a specific concentration of Turkish population in several areas in Bulgaria. Among them, most stands Kardjali District, where 101,116 Turks live /61.6% of the total population of the area/. The second number of the Turkish population is an area of Razgrad, in which 71,963 people live in this ethnic group (47.2%). Following areas: Shumen - 59 551, Burgas - 58 636, Plovdiv - 52 499, Targovishte - 49 495, Silistra – 48 761. In these seven areas of the country live 59.2% of the population of the Turkish ethnic group.

Most of Gypsy population live in big towns/cities, mainly in the districts of Plovdiv /11% of Gypsies in the country/, Pazardjik /about 10% of Gypsies/, Sliven /9%/, Montana, etc.
